








Visitation guidelines


- Visitors must stay with the patient (not go to the cafeteria, gift shop, etc.).
- Visitors must wear a mask covering their nose and mouth (no gaiters or vented masks).
- People over age 65 and those with chronic illnesses should refrain from visiting.

For patients without COVID-19

Adult patient	Visitor: Must be age 18+*
 <p>Hospitalized</p>	One visitor a day 2–6 p.m.
 <p>Emergency Department</p>	One visitor (when in a treatment area) at any time; visitor can leave and return once every 12 hours
 <p>Behavioral Health</p>	One visitor a day 6–7 p.m.; must call ahead to sign up
 <p>Labor and Delivery</p>	One visitor a day
 <p>Outpatient (including infusion, radiology and lab areas) and practice appointments</p>	No visitors except for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Cancer appointments • Patients who will be under sedation • Prenatal appointments • If special help is needed**

Pediatric patient	Visitor: Must be age 18+*
 <p>Hospitalized and Emergency Department</p>	One parent or guardian or designated visitor a day at any time
 <p>Outpatient and practice appointments</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One parent or guardian or designated visitor • Infants 2 months and younger may have two parents or guardians

For patients who have (or might have) COVID-19

Any patient	Visitor
 <p>Any area</p>	No visitors*

*A patient's care team may make compassionate exceptions, such as end-of-life events.

**This is any case when special help is needed for patients with behavioral or physical needs or for pediatric patients.
